### Rotary's Official Motto=Our Motto

'Service Above Self' and 'One Profits Most Who Serves Best' both trace back to the early days of the organization.

In 1911 'He Profits Most Who Serves Best' was approved as the Rotary motto. It was adapted from a speech made at the first Rotary convention. The speaker declared that 'Only the science of right conduct toward others pays. Business is the science of human services. He profits most who serve his fellows best.'

At the 1950 RI Convention in Detroit, slightly modified versions of the two slogans were formally approved as the official mottos of Rotary: 'He Profits Most Who Serves Best' and 'Service Above Self.' The 1989 Council on Legislation established 'Service Above Self' as the principal motto of Rotary.

As members of Rotary we have opportunities to work on international projects that address today's most pressing humanitarian challenges, but we also have opportunities to change lives locally and our Club is well known in our community to have made a difference. (continued on back)

The Rotary Foundation recognizes members who have donated \$1000 to the Foundation by giving them the designation of Paul Harris Fellow. Members may donate in a number of ways; directly to the Foundation through the Rotary International website or our club treasurer; by purchasing raffle tickets for the district raffle; or by choosing to have the donation amount added to your quarterly bill. If you're not sure how much you've donated to the Foundation, you can find out by asking Del, or by checking your balance on the Rotary website. If you haven't already signed up for an account, you can register under the My Rotary tab, follow the instructions, and then see your donor history by checking your Profile, then Donor History Report. And don't forget, the Brookings Rotary Club makes it even easier by matching 50% of all donations for your first two Paul Harris Fellows!

# **Brookings Rotary Loses Member**

Roger Bierstedt, 57, of Brookings, SD, passed away Friday, December 22, 2017 at the Brookings Hospital. Memorial services were held on Friday, December 29, 2017 at First Presbyterian Church in Brookings, SD. Roger was born on July 17, 1960 to George and June (Johnson) Fothergill in Estherville, Iowa. George passed away a few weeks later from a farming accident. June was married to Clarence Bierstedt on November 12, 1961 and Clarence was excited to adopt Roger on July 17, 1962.
